 - Indicator 4: Geographical Correlation




- Many impact categories require regionalization, e.g.

- Many impact categories require regionalization, e.g.
 UNEP/SETAC recomended methods for
 - Land use
 - Water consumption
- Differences among regions can dominate results
 - Can be more important than inventories
 - Also within countries





Regionalization limitations

- Duplication of processes and elementary flows for many location
 - Data collection efforts (quality loss)
 - Size of database is limiting calculations
 - New procedures required
- Different LCIA methods require different scales



Life cycle initiative

- Task force on Regionalisation
 - Focus on impact assessment
 - Paper submitted (Mutel et al.):
 "Overview and recommendations for regionalized life cycle impact assessment"
 - Currently, resolution mainly based on data availablity
 - Call for better documentation of results (e.g. before aggregation to country level)
 - Report uncertainty and variability of aggregated CFs
 - No general agreement for definition of sub-national scale
 - Recommendation of technical standard
